The stakeholders in the health metropolis of Vienna - City of Vienna (Stadt Wien), Health Association (Gesundheitsverbund), Vienna Chamber of Commerce and Industry (WK Wien), Chamber of Physicians Vienna (Ärzttekammer), Industrial Association Vienna (IV Wien), umbrella organization of Austrian social security institutions (Dachverband) - want to work with innovative companies and startups to solve existing and future challenges. Our goal is to improve the patient experience while ensuring the efficiency and accuracy of the resources used. We are more than aware of the special circumstances of the current health situation in our country and our city (coronavirus) and our employees work around the clock to help in the best possible way to combat the current crisis. Nevertheless, we are already looking ahead to a new normal state in which we will still have “old” challenges. We already want to work on making things easier and easier afterwards, or benefiting a large number of people.

Challenge 2: File-in Lösungen

This term is used to collect different use cases, which today are all more or less carried out on paper. In particular, consent is given by patients on a paper basis, but prescriptions (transcription from private prescription to cash register prescription) and invoices from doctors are also processed via paper - just like transport notes, billing with or reimbursement of costs for private insurance, etc. To improve the processes, existing ones are being used. Solutions and tools or parts of the process were sought in order to simplify patients on the one hand and optimize processes in administration on the other. The solutions sought must be multi-interface compatible and contain the following elements or special solutions for: ID capture, signature, document handling, OCR / 2D matrix code, simple / complex process management.

Eligibility criteria:

- already established company
- Product at least PoC status, solutions with proof of market are preferred
- Partial or total solution for the processes described above - also adaptation / adaptation of a solution or a tool from other industries and countries
- Scalability
- Willingness to work with other teams for a “Vienna solution”

Working languages German and English

What is in it for you?

The stakeholders in the health metropolis offer the winning teams, which are involved in the joint implementation of the service, the following prizes and collaborations:

- Price money of EUR 5.000.- for the winning team
- Setup and implimentation of a PoC (proof of concept/test)
- Support with APIs
- Close cooperation with the specialists of the stakeholders
- If successful: Rollout and communication in all channels

Then the most suitable three to max. five startups/companies for the final by the stakeholders with the involvement of the coaches. The finalists will be informed via email. In a final step, the ideas are finalized and presented. One or more winners can be selected from the finalists.

Likewise, there is no legal entitlement to a final and / or the determination of a winner. The participants do not receive any allowance for their participation.
